REGULATIONS made by the Prime Minister in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 27A(3)(d) of the Disaster Preparedness and Response Act, Chapter 145 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

**DISASTER PREPARED AND RESPONSE
(CURFEW) REGULATIONS, 2022.**

2.-(1) During the period of the Declaration of Disaster Area (Hurricane Lisa) Order, 2022, S.I. 142 of 2022, in light of the dangerous state of affairs in the Belize District, and the risk to lives and safety caused by the effects of Hurricane Lisa, in particular but not limited to, flooding and down power lines, a curfew is hereby imposed in the Belize District, with the exception of Ambergris Caye and Caye Caulker, commencing on November 3rd, 2022 from 7:00p.m. to 6:00a.m. of the following morning, and ending on Sunday November 6th, 2022, unless otherwise extended.

Curfew.

(2) For the purposes of sub-regulation (1), no person shall be on the streets or in any public place nor on any public road.

(3) Sub-regulations (1) and (2) shall not apply to any members, who are on duty, of the security forces, personnel

of the National Emergency Management Organization, Department of Immigration Services reporting for duties, any public officer on duty working under the direction of the National Emergency Management Organization, any utility companies conducting emergency operations, the National Fire Service, any emergency service personnel responding to emergencies, including ambulances, employees of the Philip Goldson International Airport, air traffic controllers and personnel of the Department of Civil Aviation, airline crew and personnel, any personnel including public officers and other authorized persons, acting under the directions of the National Emergency Management Organization, conducting search and rescue missions and damage assessment.

Duration of regulations.

3. These Regulations shall have effect during the period of the Declaration of Disaster Area (Hurricane Lisa) Order, 2022, S.I. 142 of 2022.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations come into force on November 3rd 2022.
