Governor General Welcomes New Ambassadors to Belize

Belmopan, February 27, 2023.

Governor General Her Excellency Dame Froyla Tzalam today received letters of credence of new ambassadors to Belize from the Republic of China (Taiwan) and Honduras.

The first to present credentials was Her Excellency Lily Li-Wen Hsu, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of China (Taiwan). In her remarks, Ambassador Hsu spoke of Belize and Taiwan's shared values and ideals of freedom and democracy, and aspirations to "promote the well-being of all peoples and maintain world peace."
