MoHW Receives Million-Dollar Equipment Donation from Belizean Diaspora

Today, the Ministry of Health & Wellness (MoHW) received a donation of US\$1.8 million worth of hospital equipment through the collaboration of Edward and Patricia Lord, generous donors from the Belizean diaspora, Build Belize Inc. and the Ministry of Tourism and Diaspora Relations. This substantial donation will be instrumental in improving Belize's healthcare infrastructure.

The donated equipment, including medical and birthing beds, defibrillators, patient monitors, infusion pumps, and vital sign monitors, will be distributed across the country.
