Ministry of Youth, Sports, and Transport Engages in Knowledge Exchange Mission in Taiwan

A delegation from the Government of Belize recently visited Taiwan to engage in a knowledge exchange mission hosted by the Central American Bank for Economic Integration (CABEI) and the Republic of China (Taiwan). The mission, which also included representatives from Guatemala, focused on green energy, climate resilience, e-mobility, and sustainable development.

During the visit, the Belizean delegation met with representatives from Taiwan's private sector and from both national and local government offices.
