River Conditions

REGION 7 - On the **RIO HONDO** at Blue Creek North and at Santa Cruz, near normal levels; at San Antonio and at San Roman, normal levels; and at Douglas to the coast, below normal levels.

On the **NEW RIVER** at Hill Bank and at Tower Hill, near normal levels; and at Caledonia, above normal levels.

REGION 9 - On the **MOPAN RIVER** at Benque Viejo Town, near normal levels. On the **MACAL RIVER**, all HYDROBELIZE Facilities are below the spillway; and at San Ignacio, levels remain below the Low-Lying Bridge. On the **BELIZE RIVER** at More Tomorrow, near normal levels; and at Double Run, near normal levels. On the Crooked Tree Lagoon, steady below normal levels and remain below the causeway.

REGION 11 - On the **SIBUN RIVER** at Freetown Sibun, near normal levels. On the **SOUTHERN LAGOON** at Gales Point Village, above normal levels. In the watersheds on the **EASTERN SLOPES OF THE MAYA MOUNTAINS** on the **SITTEE RIVER** at Kendal Bridge, steady above normal levels.

On the branches of the **MONKEY RIVER**, at Swasey and at Bladen, below normal levels. On the **DEEP RIVER** at Medina Bank, steady below normal levels; and on the **GOLDEN STREAM RIVER** at Hellgate, steady above normal levels.

On the **RIO GRANDE** at San Pedro Columbia and at Big Falls South, near normal levels. On the **MOHO RIVER** at Blue Creek South, near normal levels; and at Jordan, below normal levels. On the **TEMASH RIVER** at Crique Sarco, below normal levels.

REGION 13 - On the **SARSTOON RIVER**, near normal levels.
