The VEX V5 Classroom Super Kit is a comprehensive educational robotics platform featuring more than 1,500 components, including a Robot Brain, Controller, Smart Motors, a rechargeable battery and charger, sensors, and a wide range of structural and mechanical parts. With access to this technology, students can move beyond theoretical concepts and gain hands-on experience designing, building, programming, testing, and refining robotic systems.

This partnership with Belize's National University reflects the Ministry's continued commitment to advancing digital transformation and strengthening digital skills across Belize, in alignment with the priorities of the National Digital Agenda.
