FLOOD ALERT in effect for Regions 11 and 13: southern Toledo district.

Flooding is observed or is possible, with excessive nighttime and early morning rainfall activity over southern Belize.

RESIDENTS ARE ADVISED TO REMAIN ALERT AND STAY INFORMED WITH OFFICIAL UPDATES.

River Conditions

NORTHERN RIVERS (REGION 7):

- **Rio Hondo River:** Near normal to below normal levels
- **New River:** Near normal to below normal levels

WESTERN RIVERS (REGION 9):

- **Mopan River:** Steady below normal levels
- **Macal River:** Below spillways levels

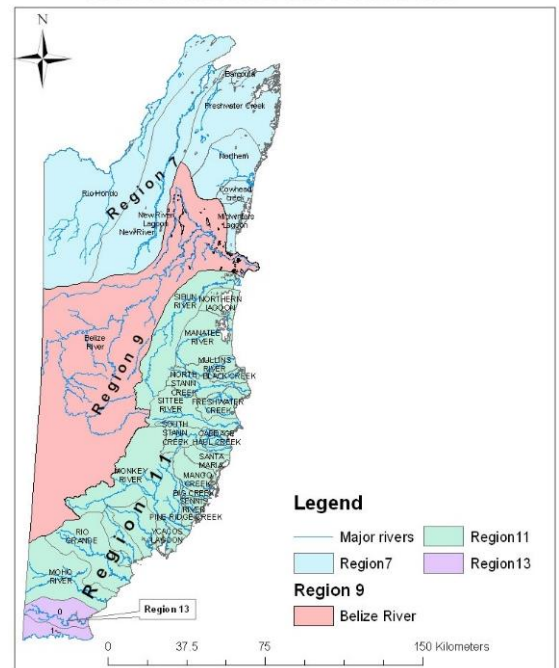
CENTRAL & EASTERN BELIZE (REGION 11):

- **Belize River:** Below normal levels
- **Sibun River:** Below normal levels
- **Gales Point Lagoon:** Above normal levels
- **Sittee River:** Above normal levels
- **Monkey and Deep Rivers:** Below normal levels
- **Rio Grande:** Below normal levels
- **Moho River:** Above normal levels; **Flood stage at Blue Creek South (above bridge levels)**
- **Temash River:** Above normal levels
- **Other Rivers:** Mostly steady below normal levels

SOUTHERN BELIZE (REGION 13):

- **Sarstoon River:** Below normal levels
